LIT 2-09a</p> <p><u>Learning Outcome</u> Pupils will use air drying clay as a medium to create tree faces. This will allow the children to work with a different medium to improve their mastery of art and design techniques. The children need to know that they are making friendly tree faces as the nursery children use the woodland area and we do not want to scare them, ensuring a small discussion on kindness before activity. Pupils should use their listening and talking skills to ensure communication in their pairs is evident.</p>	<p><u>Resources</u></p> <p>Clay – divided into small balls ready for the children to use Water Small pots to keep the water in Wet wipes Trees which can be found in our Outdoor Learning small woodland behind the school</p>
<p><u>Activity</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Before going outdoors, explain the activity to the children using a PowerPoint that will have examples of what good looks like and the LI and SC.2. Explain that once we get to the woods, we are going to have a small scavenger hunt to look for natural items that we can use to make out tree faces look more interesting and creative.3. Show the children how to handle the clay, expanding how to wet the clay to make it more pliable and how they can smooth out the clay or add more texture.4. Ensure they know that their hands will get a little messy as we have some sensory issues within the class.5. In pairs, the children can now go and find their own tree, agreeing between them, which tree will be best.	<p><u>Assessment</u></p> <p>Pictures to show their learning. Pupil voice. Ensuring Success Criteria has been met. Pupils should be able to demonstrate their understanding of working with clay as a medium.</p>
