<p><u>Activity</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Students are learning physical descriptions and personalities with families. - In the courtyard, there will be individual cards. Families are to find each other. Based on the names and descriptions - five Spanish words on the back of each card. Pupils choose one card, write a small paragraph in Spanish and a present their family to the class. 	<p><u>Assessment</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The teacher will record the pupil presentations (in Spanish). Students will peer assess the best presentation and will vote for the overall winners. They will use the red and green flags to do this. The best awards for the best presentations will receive a gold, silver or bronze medal.
