EXA 2-06a</p> <p><u>Learning Outcome</u></p> <p>We are learning to create a chair using only natural resources. We are learning to work as part of a team.</p>	<p><u>Resources</u></p> <p>As the children will only be using natural resources there will be little resources required for this task.</p> <p>Ensure that the correct paperwork is in place. Ensure that the first aid kit is available and has the necessary items in it. Ensure that the staff to child ratio is covered.</p>
<p><u>Activity</u></p> <p>Explain to the children that they will be working in groups to create a chair using only natural resources.</p> <p>Discuss with children what they consider to be a chair. What features do chairs all have? What makes one chair better than other?</p> <p>With the children let them come up with the criteria which all groups can work towards.</p> <p>Discuss the area that the children can work within. Discuss the time that will be allowed Discuss the rules that keep the children safe</p>	<p><u>Assessment</u></p> <p>The assessment for this task will be when the time is up and all the children come back together at the agreed meeting spot, each group will be able to present their chair to the teacher and the other groups. Photographs of the children's finished chairs will be taken. Record key words which will show that the children have met the learning outcome.</p>
