## SCA report to SAPOE

Report for meeting – December 2022



- January 2023 will see the launch of the new <u>Stand Up Paddleboard Instructor</u> award; the only regulated qualification in the UK and designed for instructors leading taster sessions in SUP.
- 2. The <u>Paddlesport Safety and Rescue Course</u> will also be introduced and replace the Foundation Safety and Rescue.
- 3. During the summer we launched <u>SUP Safer</u> and <u>Paddle Safer</u> safety focused courses for the beginner market. These are available for delivery by a wide range of coaches, including through some SAPOE connected centres and organisations
- 4. The <u>British Canoeing Delivery Partner</u> scheme continues to build with 95% renewal in year 2. The second <u>Delivery Partner Conference</u> will take place on 26th January 2022 and is open to both Delivery Partners and non Delivery Partners
- 5. 2022 has seen strong achievements in qualifications and training, with nearly 400 new Paddlesport Instructor completions, 90 Coach Awards
- 6. We continue to offer a comprehensive programme of <u>Online Activities</u> on a wide range of paddling topics, most of which are available free to members or small contribution for non members and also offer CPD points.
- 7. Data received through the Watersports Survey shows 583k adults resident in Scotland paddled in 2021 with 174k taking part more than 3 times in the year. This represents around 12.8% of the population and is a significant increase on previous years.
